

Dr. Del Kimbler Professor Emeritus of Industrial Engineering

Del Kimbler has worked in photography since his teens and began exhibiting as he neared retirement. He was a supporter of The Arts Center in Clemson from its inception, and is a member of the Anderson Artist Guild. Del is a member of the Pendleton Square Artist Cooperative.

Dr. Kimbler received his BSE from the University of South Florida 1976 and his PhD from Virginia Tech 1980. Del came to Clemson University in January of 1987 in the department of Industrial Engineering, where he retired in 2008.
