### Program Benefits

Students who participate in the Mini-Semester are required to apply for the Community College Internship (CCI) for two-year institutions or the Science Undergraduate Laboratory Internship (SULI) for four-year institutions. Both programs offer the opportunity to participate in a paid scientific research internship at NREL for summer 2020.

### Program Eligibility & Requirements

- This program is designed for underrepresented students in STEM; however, anyone can apply
- Must be a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must have health insurance
