**Dan Radakovich, Director of Athletics** Named the 13th director of athletics in Clemson history on Dec. 1, 2012, Dan Radakovich has continuously led the Tiger athletic department to high achievements, both on the field and in the classroom, while developing significant upgrades in finance and facilities. Since his arrival, Radakovich has led Clemson athletics to a period of sustained success a growth, considered among the greatest stretches in school history.

As a department, Clemson student-athletes have recorded eight semesters with a 3.0 GPA or higher, including a record 3.57 GPA in the spring of 2020. Radakovich has guided the department successfully throughout the pandemic, helping Clemson to safely reopen athletic operations, including safely hosting 112,367 fans, ranking third nationally.

Highlighting the 2020-21 athletic year so far, the football program claimed the ACC title and appeared in the College Football Playoff appearance, the men's soccer program claimed the 2020 ACC Championship, and the women's soccer program advanced to a sixth-straight NCAA Tournament. Additionally, Radakovich oversaw the development of the softball program at Clemson, which officially began in the spring of 2020. That program has already earned national rankings in just its second season.

Radakovich's tenure has been highlighted by the success of the football program, which has claimed the 2016 and 2018 National Championships. The Tigers have won six consecutive ACC titles, and made six straight College Football Playoffs.

The Clemson athletic department set a new school record for the highest score in the NCAA's graduation success rate at 93 percent in 2020, while a school-record seven programs were recognized by the NCAA for outstanding APR. Clemson has been at 91 percent or higher for seven-straight years.
